ROOM RATES

The room rates for Sunday through Thursday are **\$98** per night (plus 12.5% tax). The rates are good for three days before and after the reunion.

RESERVATIONS

You will need to give them your credit card number to guarantee your reservations. The Handlery accepts Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover, and most other major credit cards.

On a side-note -- The Handlery reopened last week after having been closed for three months to completely renovate their property. It is beautiful. This property is a private family held property, So we are getting a piece of prime property in San Diego for our use for a week for a very low price.

SCHEDULED EVENTS

We'll run this reunion exactly as we have in the past. We have a hospitality suite where the property allows us to bring in our own beer, wine, liquor, soft drinks, etc. We'll also be bringing in our own snacks, (i.e., pretzels, chips, nuts, etc.).

The hospitality suite, as we have done in the past, will be on the honor system -- if you drink and/or snack, drop some money in the can -- strictly honor system.

Sunday: Check-in, complete the registration sign-in sheet. Hospitality suite will be open at 3:00 P.M.
