David J. Ball Memorial Scholarship-- FOR 2025

PLEASE READ THE APPLICATION and THIS APPLICATION LETTER CAREFULLY and COMPLETELY.

The entries on this application and associated documents must be **COMPLETE, ACCURATE**, and **LEGIBLE**. Before submitting this application in a timely manner, review the application for completeness. Verify that all blocks are filled in correctly and all attachments are included. Incomplete blocks or failure to complete any block could be reason for refusal to consider the application by the David J. Ball Memorial Scholarship Committee.

Members of the Navy Divers Association, Inc. (NDA) believe that all young people qualified for admittance to an accredited college or vocational institute should be financially able to attend that school, which would best serve their purpose. Enrolling in college or vocational school is a major career decision - a very important and worthy goal. Education in the private sector creates a monetary struggle to meet the expense of each term. It would be unfortunate to delay or forego higher education because of the severe financial strain it would impose upon the student, their parent(s), grandparent(s) or legal guardian(s).

Therefore, the NDA has made available a scholarship program for qualified dependent sons, daughters, stepchildren, legally adopted children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren of persons (whether living or deceased) who have successfully completed a course in diving from a U. S. Navy diving school. The number of scholarships awarded is completely dependent on the number of successful scholarship applications received and the monies available for distribution from the David J. Ball Memorial Scholarship Fund. For the year 2025 we will be awarding 6 scholarships for \$2500 each.

The award per applicant will be \$2500 annually for a total of up to \$10,000.00 over four years. Only 2 new scholarships will be awarded each year. Initial application is made using the form below. In some instances, we have been able to award more scholarship money to deserving individuals on a case-by-case basis. In 2024 we were able to award \$1000 toall the first-time applicants that did not win our two new \$2500 awards due to one individual donation.

To continue receiving the David J. Ball Memorial scholarship funding successful recipients must submit a shortened form, also below, annually demonstrating academic progress acceptable to the Scholarship Committee. Scholarships are granted on the assumption that students will continuously enroll for consecutive academic years. Should a recipient elect to interrupt their education for a semester or longer a new application must be submitted that will be considered equally with other applications received for initial grants.

Applicants must be either (1) a high school senior, (2) a graduate of an accredited high school, or (3) be in possession of a General Educational Development (GED) certificate and be under the age of 23. The applicant must verify evidence of (1) scholastic proficiency, (2)

extracurricular activities (high school only), and (3) awards granted in school and/or the community.

Applicants must also show financial need for this scholarship. At least two letters of reference or recommendation should be enclosed from persons other than the applicant's parent, grandparent, or school Guidance Counselor.

Applications for scholarships will be made available annually. Completed applications must be forwarded to the Scholarship Committee **POSTMARKED PRIOR** to the closing date of 31 March 2025. **ALL FIRST-TIME** applications **MUST** be accompanied with the following information and/or attachments and complete the attached **FIRST-TIME** four-page application:

- a. An official high school transcript or official transcript of all college semesters completed. (Transcripts may be forwarded to the scholarship chairperson if not received before the application submission deadline. However, all transcripts must be received by the NDA <u>prior to July 1</u> of the year of scholarship award).
- b. At least two references/recommendations, (submitted by other than the applicant's parent, grandparent, or school Guidance Counselor)
- c. A copy of the letter of acceptance to an accredited college/institution of higher learning (Letter may be forwarded to the scholarship chairperson if not received before the application submission deadline but must be received by the NDA **prior to July 1**).
- d. An essay of 400 words or less detailing why he/she is deserving of this U. S, Navy Divers Association, Inc. scholarship. Essays must include the applicant's ideas as to what he/she is planning regarding his/her future and a life plan on making the world a better place. If possible, the essay should be prepared in a printed manner to facilitate ease of reading by the Scholarship Committee.
- e. Verification of sponsor's successful completion of a formal course in U. S. Navy Diving. This can be substantiated by furnishing a copy of a graduation certificate, a copy of the DD- Form 214 or some other verifiable document. Ensure the complete Social Security Account Number of that *individual* is **NOT** visible.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The information submitted will be filed in strict confidence available only to the NDA Scholarship Committee in compliance with the Privacy Act of 1974, Public Law 93-380.

Eligibility, for a first scholarship award, is an individual under age 23, being the son, daughter, grandchild, or great grandchild (including legally adopted and stepchildren) of a living or deceased diver who successfully completed a U. S. Navy diver training course.

It is the responsibility of each student to take the necessary steps to gain admission to the college/university or other institution he/she desires to attend. This includes the taking of the College Board exams, if applicable.

The entries on the application must be **COMPLETE, ACCURATE**, and **LEGIBLE**. Before submitting this application, review the application for completeness. Verify that all blocks are filled in correctly and all attachments are included. Incomplete blocks or failure to complete any block could be reason for refusal by the David C. Ball Memorial Scholarship Committee.

Scholarship monies, upon favorable review, will be awarded to those successful scholarship applicants who have been accepted and do enroll in an approved and accredited institution of higher learning. Evidence of this, in the form of a copy of "student registration" indicating the "program and classes," must be forwarded annually to the David J. Ball Memorial Scholarship Chairperson no later than 15 April of the year the applicant is registered to attend an approved and accredited institution of higher learning.

Awards to the successful applicants will be announced in the <u>month of May</u> by mail each year and again at the NDA bi-annual meeting for the current and previous year awards. The monetary award, in the form of a check drawn on the NDA Scholarship Fund, will be mailed to the successful applicants annually <u>during the month of July</u>.
